Transfusion Medicine Fellowship

Description: This joint program offers an ACGME-accredited one-year fellowship providing in-depth training in all aspects of transfusion medicine including blood center operations, patient transfusion services, hemophilia, therapeutic and donor apheresis, as well as HLA, viral, molecular diagnostic, and coagulation laboratory services. The fellow will receive extensive experience in a large centralized transfusion service which serves four teaching hospitals and 10 community hospitals, transfusing more than 115K red cells and 100K platelets annually. Active areas of research currently include: hematopoietic stem cell collection and transplantation, coagulation disorders and hypercoagulable states, transfusion support for adult and pediatric organ transplantation, transfusion immunomodulation, TRALI (Transfusion related acute lung injury) and donor safety studies and molecular-based testing.

Requirements: Applicants must be certified or eligible for certification in Clinical Pathology, Hematology, or other clinical specialty.

Stipends: Salary is commensurate with year of postgraduate training.
