Gynecologic & Breast Pathology Fellowship

Description: Three positions are offered in this ACGME-approved fellowship for gynecologic and breast pathology. There is some exposure to perinatal/obstetrical surgical pathology. Fellows rotate on surgical benches devoted to breast and gynecologic specimens as well as cytology, cytogenetics, and molecular pathology. Magee-Womens Hospital is the Center of Excellence for women's health in the UPMC health system. The surgical load is 30,000 and the cytology load is 110,000. State of the art resources are available system-wide for academic pursuits.

Requirements: MD degree or equivalent plus not less than 4 years of approved training in pathology, a Pennsylvania medical training license, and for foreign medical graduates appropriate visa and certification (ECFMG, etc).

Stipends: Stipend and benefits are competitive with other training programs for 4th-6th year training.
