Head and Neck Pathology Fellowship

Description: One-year intensive training in head and neck pathology, with three months of elective rotations in other specialized areas of pathology (oral pathology, molecular diagnostics, cytopathology, etc.). A research project leading to publication in a peer-reviewed journal is expected. There is an option for this year to be as a Clinical Instructor with the first six months being a 'fellowship' experience and the second six months an 'instructor/attending' experience with independent signout and resident teaching.

Requirements: Completion of an accredited three or four-year program in Anatomic Pathology or combined Anatomic-Clinical Pathology program.

Stipends: Commensurate with the level of postgraduate training in Pathology.
