## UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO

**Description:** The fellowship consists of four rotations on various Anatomic and Clinical Pathology Services, each lasting three months. These rotations are comparable in responsibilities and structure to the rotations of beginning residents in pathology, except that the student receives intense faculty supervision and instruction. One rotation is spent doing surgical pathology on the busy University Hospital surgical pathology rotation, and one rotation is spent practicing autopsy pathology at the NM Office of the Medical Investigator. The other six months are open for electives and/or research, including possible rotations in hematopathology, transfusion medicine, or neuropathology, as examples.

**Requirements:** Open to qualified medical students who have completed at least two years in an accredited US Medical School.

**Stipends:** \$23,000.00, 15 days paid annual leave, 15 days sick leave, \$600 text book fund.
