Description: The Department of Pathology at West Virginia University School of Medicine offers two post-sophomore fellowships each year. Fellows spend portions of their time in surgical pathology, autopsy pathology, clinical pathology, translational pathology and assist with medical student teaching. Research opportunities are available through individual arrangements with faculty members.

Requirements: Students must have completed their second year of medical school to be eligible for the program. Starting date will be July 1 unless other arrangements are made with the program director.

Stipends: The annual stipend is \$24,000. A book allowance, health insurance, uniforms, and uniform laundry are also provided.
