### *Molecular Genetic Pathology Fellowship*

**Description:** Outstanding training is offered in all areas of molecular diagnostics. The Division of Molecular Diagnostics and the Molecular Anatomic Pathology Laboratory are primary sites for molecular testing of inherited, infectious and neoplastic diseases in the UPMC Health System and coordinate molecular sendout testing for the Health System and Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. Over 80 procedures employ a range of technologies including qualitative/quantitative PCR and RT-PCR, restriction enzyme analysis, fragment sizing, LOH analysis, direct DNA sequencing, and commercial assay kits. Exposure is maximized efficiently since most assays are performed in a single laboratory area. The fellow functions as a junior attending with significant responsibility for clinical interactions, assay interpretation, report preparation and conference presentations. Bench experience and opportunities for research projects and publication are provided in the first and, as arranged, subsequent years. The fellow participates actively in administrative and developmental activities and meetings to learn a range of practical and management skills necessary to oversee a modern clinical molecular diagnostics laboratory. The MGP fellowship is ACGME-accredited and starts in July. Two MGP board eligible training tracks are offered: Standard and Molecular Anatomic Pathology-focused (MAP-track).

**Requirements:** Applicants must be a Doctor of Medicine and upon commencing the fellowship have completed residency training in Pathology or Human Genetics in the United States or Canada. Evidence of past achievement and future potential are essential. Prior molecular biology experience is desirable but not required.
