## UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH

**Description:** One position is available to learn pathology and laboratory medicine. Students will select an area of focus which may be diagnostic anatomic pathology, diagnostic laboratory medicine, combinations of each, or experimental pathology with an introduction to diagnostic pathology or laboratory medicine. Experience in diagnostic pathology includes exposure to general and subspecialty surgical pathology, autopsy pathology, and forensic pathology depending on student interests. Experience in laboratory medicine includes transfusion medicine, chemistry, microbiology and hematology with secondary emphasis in immunology and molecular diagnostics. In each area students function as assistants to pathology residents. Students are also provided time to pursue a project which is expected to result in a presentation and publication. Students doing research are supervised by a faculty mentor.

**Requirements:** Open to students who have completed 2 or 3 years of an LCME-accredited medical school curriculum.

**Stipends:** Fellows receive a stipend of about \$25,500 plus a supplement for insurance, books and journals, and are eligible for Program-supported travel to meetings to present original research.
