Post-Sophomore Fellowship

Description: The University of Kansas Medical Center's Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine offers two post-Sophomore Fellowships in Pathology every year which present medical students with a unique opportunity to gain supervised hands-on experience with the practice of pathology at an academic university hospital with a National Cancer Institute designated cancer center. The post-sophomore fellows (PSFs) have duties similar to those of first year residents and they actively participate in conferences, presentations and teaching activities. Rotations include a wide range of anatomic and clinical pathology disciplines such as surgical pathology, hematopathology, autopsy pathology, cytopathology, hematology, clinical microbiology, neuropathology and dermatopathology among others. The rotation schedule is typically constructed to focus on the applicant's areas of interest. Additionally for interested students, up to 6 months of this 12 month long fellowship may be electively dedicated to basic science research under the supervision of a faculty mentor.

Requirements: The applicant must have completed 2 years in an LCME accredited U.S. medical school prior to commencing the fellowship on July 1st.

Stipends: The annual stipend is \$20,000. Annual vacation is 15 working days.

Applications: We prefer to receive applications by February 1st for fellowships starting on July 1st; however applications will be considered throughout the year.
